


Rules & Regulations



#### Carol Singing Contest: Rotary Clubs in India

- 1, The competition is open for Rotarians, Anns & Annettes of Rotary Clubs in India.
- 2. Any number of teams can participate in this event from each club.
- 3. The minimum number of participants in a team shall be 8 and maximum of 12. The participants shall comprise at least of 3 Rotarians (or Rotractors and if Rotractors are participating, there should be a minimum of 1 Rotarian) of the participating club and the rest should be Anns and Annettes.
- Outsiders or professional singers are STRICTLY NOT ALLOWED to participate in this contest. If found otherwise, the participating club shall be disqualified thereof.
- The competition is only for Carol songs to be sung in English, Malayalam, Tamil and Hindi languages or a combination of them and medley. Minor portions in other languages will be permissible.
- The duration of a repertoire shall be 6 minutes. Rendition for lesser duration shall also equally qualify, the thrust being more on the quality of rendition.
- 7. The orchestral backing for a repertoire can be by way of musical instruments or Karaoke/ minus-track. If karaoke is being used, it should not contain any vocal harmony singing parts like chorus, etc in it.
- 8. Teams can also render the carol without any instruments.
- 9. Professional musicians for support (musical) instruments maybe allowed.
- 10, There will be three prizes.
  - First Prize: A trophy, cash prize of Rs.15000/- and certificates for each participant in the team.
  - B) 1st runner-up: A trophy, cash prize of Rs.10000/- and certificates for each participant in the team.
  - c) 2<sup>nd</sup> runner-up: A trophy, cash prize of Rs.5000/- and certificates for each participant.
- 11. Judging would be done on Musicianship, Band tightness, Presentation, Creativity.
- 12. The decision of the judges/ organizing committee would be final.
- 13. The team wearing outstanding costumes in the submitted entry would be specially recognized.
- 14. The registration fees for each entry will be Rs.3000/-, which will need to be paid at the time of registration and is non-refundable. Only online NEFT transfers or payment by QR Code easy pay option is permitted and the transfer details must be sent by mail to rccochincitytreasurer@gmail.com and rccochincitysecretary@gmail.com.





- The last date for registration and remittance of registration fee for the competition is 25th of November 2020. The last date for submission of entries is 30th of November 2020.
- Each entry shall be submitted as a video recording of maximum 6 minutes in MP4 format of no more than 500 MB file size.
- 18. The video recordings can be done using 1 of the 2 options mentioned below:
  - A) Option 1: Using 1 video camera in stationary position from the front with all participating singers and musicians in full view.
  - B) Option 2: Using a music video recording app like Smule.
- 19. The club names or club logos should not be present in any manner on the submitted entries. Neither as embedded text or logos on the video format nor as text or logos on costumes/back-drops while recording the video.

- 21. Upon successful submission of the Google registration form, remittance of the registration fee and after validation, the upload links together with the participant entry code for submission of entries shall be e-mailed to the participating team leader.
- 22. Entries that fail to adhere to any of the rules of the competition shall be disqualified.



- 1, The competition is open for Rotarians, Anns and Annettes of Rotary Clubs in India.
- 2. Any number of teams can participate in this event from each club.
- Christmas Trees for participating teams/clubs from Zone 4,
   RI Distrcit 3201 shall be provided by us. This shall be handed over to the respective club presidents on the 26th of November 2020.
- 4. The specification of the Christmas Tree for all other participating teams/clubs from all other Zones in RI Distrcit 3201 or other participating teams from Rotary Clubs in India are as per the attached image below.

Teams must ensure that the size as per the specification is followed. If found otherwise, the participating club shall be disqualified thereof.

- 5. Christmas Tree specification: The standard height of the tree should be 6 ft high including the stand. The decoration should be in a standard floor area of 1m x 1m
- 6. The minimum number of participants in a team shall be 3 and the maximum 10. The teams shall comprise of at least 1 Rotarian, 1 Ann and 1 Annette minimum.
- 7. The participants can use their own decorations or of the shelf decorations available commercially, maintaining the theme of Christmas. Participants can also use decorative lighting as per requirement.
- 8. The trees will be judged on Originality, Creativity and Visual Impact.
- The decision of the judges/ organizing committee would be final.
- 10. There will be three prizes.

A) First Prize: Cash prize of Rs.5000/ B) 1st runner-up: Cash prize of Rs.3000/ C) 2nd runner-up: Cash prize of Rs.2000/-

- The registration fees for each entry will be Rs.1500/-, which will need to be paid at the time of registration and is non-refundable.   - B) Component 2: 4 (Four) still unedited photographs of the decorated tree from 4 different sides.
  - C) Component 3: 1 (one) still photograph of all the participants of the team with the decorated tree.
- 14. The still photographs should not have any graphic enhancements or image filters.
- 15. The club names or club logos should not be present in any manner on the submitted entries. Embedded text showing the club name or club logos on the video format, on costumes/ backdrops while recording the video or on the still photographs are not permitted.

- 2. Any number of teams can participate in this event from each club.
- Christmas Cribs for participating teams/clubs from Zone 4,
   RI Distrcit 3201 shall be provided by us. This shall be handed over to the respective club presidents on the 26th of November 2020.
- 4. The specification of the Christmas Cribs for all other participating teams/clubs from all other Zones in RI Distrcit 3201 or other participating teams from Rotary Clubs in India are as per the attached image below.

Teams must ensure that the size as per the specification is followed. If found otherwise, the participating club shall be disqualified thereof.

- 5. Christmas Cribs specification: The standard size of the crib should not be more than 50 cm x 50 cm. The total works should be in a space not more than 1 m X 1 m.
- 6. The maximum number of participants in a team shall be 5.
- 7. The participants can use their own decorations or of the shelf decorations available commercially, maintaining the theme of Christmas. Participants can also use decorative lighting as per requirement.
- 8. The Cribs will be judged on Originality, Creativity and Visual Impact.
- 9. The decision of the judges/ organizing committee would be final.
- 10, There will be three prizes.
  - A) First Prize: Cash prize of Rs.5000/-
  - B) 1st runner-up: Cash prize of Rs.3000/-
  - C) 2nd runner-up: Cash prize of Rs.2000/-
- 11. The registration fees for each entry will be Rs.1000/-, which will need to be paid at the time of registration and is non-refundable. - 2, Any number of Annets can participate in this event from each club.
- 3, Cards should be in the size not more than 15 cmx 22cm
- 4. The participants has to bear the cost of any materials used.
- 5, The card will be judged on Originality, Creativity and theme/concept.
- 6, The decision of the judges/ organizing committee would be final.
- 7, There will be three prizes.
  - A) First Prize: Cash prize of Rs. 2000 /-
  - B) 1st runner-up: Cash prize of Rs. 1000 /-
  - c) 2nd runner-up: Cash prize of Rs. 750 /-
- The registration fees for each entry will be Rs.200/ head, which will need to be paid at the time of registration and is non-refundable. Only online NEFT transfers or payment by QR Code easy pay option is permitted and the transfer details must be sent by mail to rccochincitytreasurer@gmail.com and rccochincitysecretary@gmail.com.


